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metaphysics and hermeneutics in the medieval platonic tradition consists of twelve essays originally published between 2006 and 2015 dealing with main trends and specific figures within the medieval platonic tradition three essays provide general surveys of the transmission of late ancient thought to the middle ages with emphasis on the ancient authors the themes and their medieval readers respectively the remaining essays deal especially with certain major figures in the platonic tradition including pseudo dionysius the areopagite iohannes scottus eriugena and nicholas of cusa the principal conceptual aim of the collection is to establish the primacy of hermeneutics within the philosophical program developed by these authors in other words to argue that their philosophical activity substantially albeit not exclusively consists of the reading and evaluation of authoritative texts the essays also argue that the role of hermeneutics varies in the course of the tradition between being a means towards the development of metaphysical theory and being an integral component of metaphysics itself in addition such changes in the status and application of hermeneutics to metaphysics are shown to be accompanied by a shift from emphasizing the connection between logic and philosophy to emphasizing that between rhetoric and philosophy the collection of essays fills in a lacuna in the history of philosophy in general between the fifth and the fifteenth centuries it also initiates a dialogue between the metaphysical hermeneutics of medieval platonism and certain modern theories of hermeneutics structuralism and deconstruction the book will be of special interest to students of the classical tradition in western thought and more generally to students of medieval philosophy theology history and literature cs1094

this study concerns the position of saint thomas aquinas on human self knowledge the soul s knowledge of itself in medieval idiom its main goal is to present a comprehensive account of aquinas s philosophy of self knowledge by clarifying his texts on this topic and explaining why he made the claims he did a second objective is to situate thomas s position on self awareness within general world and specific thirteenth century traditions concerning this theme and a third is to apply aquinas s approach and insights to selected and contemporary issues that involve self knowledge such as the alleged paradoxes of self reflection and of unconscious awareness the primary approach is that of critical narrative which attempts to understand st thomas s texts by posing critical questions for them while this questioning may expose certain texts as equivocal or unsupported usually thomas emerges as coherent reasonable and better understood this work is serious scholarship that presumes reader interest in philosophical reflection and some background in medieval type thinking on the other hand the book is not narrowly specialized in aquinas or a single methodology but includes broad reference to worldwide traditions and attempts to integrate st thomas s approach into topics of contemporary interest

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among numerous retirement schemes in france the social security general regime covers all wage earners from the private sector about 65 of workers in this regime are eligible for a full pension at 65 or between 60 and 65 if they contributed to the regime for at least 37 5 years for people between 60 and 65 who do not fulfill this condition still possible but with a downward adjustment of benefits our computations show that early retirement adjustment rules give strong incentives to go on working until being eligible for a full pension even if mandatory complementary schemes soften incentives especially for executives these results are consistent with empirical hazard rates showing two spikes at 60 and 65 with the change in the retirement age induced by the 1983 reform
